

LETTER TO SPORTS

Dear Sports Editor:

I am writing to express my gratitude to everyone who made the Fifth Annual Craig Swanson Memorial Golf Tournament the most successful to date. As a result of the generosity of the individuals, businesses and organizations who donated their time, effort, prizes and money, this year's tournament raised over \$1,000 to benefit the Craig "Swanny" Swanson Memorial Scholarship Fund.

Swanson was an outstanding local athlete who was tragically killed in an automobile accident Sept. 28, 1991. He was a three-letter athlete at Frewsburg Central School, who went on to play college baseball at Canisius College. Following school he became one of the best softball and baseball players in the area.

The Craig "Swanny" Swanson Scholarship Fund annually awards a \$500 scholarship to the Frewsburg Central School student who most exemplifies the qualities Craig possessed. Each year, a bowling, golf and softball tourna-

ment are held to raise money for the scholarship fund.

The Craig Swanson Memorial Golf Tournament has doubled in size since its inception in 1992. Over that period of time, the golf tournament has raised over \$3,700 for the scholarship fund. This year 83 golfers toured the Cable Hollow Golf Course with over 100 attending the after-golf picnic at the Frewsburg American Legion. Of special note was the participation of Brian Nelson, who was the recipient of the first Craig Swanson Memorial Scholarship.

As the tournament expands, we become more dependent on the generous donations of prizes from our growing list of sponsors. There is not enough room here to mention them all individually, however, you know who you are. To all those who contributed prizes, time, effort and money, I offer heartfelt thanks and wishes for your continued support in the future.
