AKELEY, Pa. — The eighth annual Craig Swanson Memorial Golf Tournament at Cable Hollow Golf Club raised more than \$3,000 for a scholarship fund in memory of the late Frewsburg athlete.

Half of this year's proceeds were donated to Brianne Prince, the 1998 Craig "Swannie" Swanson Memorial Scholarship Fund winner, to help offset medical expenses as she battles Hodgkin's Disease. Total donations to the fund generated by all eight Craig Swanson Memorial tournaments exceed \$10,000.
